Washington Timbers U9-U10 Junior Academy Uniform Information:

Uniforms are NOT included in registration fees. Jerseys are ordered through [NW Soccer Locker](#). Junior Academy families will receive more information after players are placed. Players must wear either red or black jerseys for games with black shorts and socks. Purchasing new uniforms is NOT required, though it is recommended, as the league is very flexible. Players also do not need numbers but can choose to have any number if they like.

Washington Timbers Spring Cost Breakdown

It is important that we provide our soccer community with a quality training environment for U8 players, at a cost that is fair and affordable. This amounts to approximately 32 hours in total of training/game time. About \$6.25/hour for high level training and games with a USSF grassroots licensed coaching staff.

Cost per hour:

- 24 Training Sessions @ 60 minutes (24 hours)
- 7 League Games (8 hours)
